<b>Race Course</b>	Hazard from dangerous objects on venue sites including broken glass, dog mess, rocks, tree roots.	All	Medium/High	Check venue prior to competition and remove and dispose of any dangerous objects safely.	<b>Low</b>
	Risk of injury through uneven running surfaces and pot holes	Pupils, Staff, Volunteers	Medium/High	Check surfaces prior to competition and fill or clearly mark any hazardous holes/ditches. Brief participants prior to race about hazards.	<b>Low/Medium</b>
<b>Physical injuries</b>	Risk of physical injury through participation in the Cross Country.	Pupils, Staff, Volunteers	Medium	Ensure adequate First Aid provision for the number of participants. Ensure adequate adult supervision of competition. First Aid kit should be brought by participating schools and any first aid should be carried out by the school's member of staff.	<b>Low</b>
	Risk of injury through inadequate warm up	Pupils	Medium	Ensure all participants warm up correctly prior to competition. Provide adequate time for warm up.	<b>Low</b>
	Risk of injury through wearing jewellery	Pupils, Staff, Volunteers	Low	Ensure all participants remove or tape jewellery prior to the start of the competition. Competitors responsible for removing their own jewellery.	<b>Low</b>
	Risk of dehydration and exhaustion	All	Medium	Ensure adequate access to drinking water and encourage participants to bring drinks with them. Ensure course is no longer than 1500m.	<b>Low/Medium</b>
<b>Marshalling and Officials</b>	Risk of injury/getting lost through inadequately marshalled course.	All	Medium	Ensure there is an adequate number of marshals. All marshals should be able to see the next marshal on the course. If possible the course should be fully sighted from start to finish.	<b>Low</b>

	Risk of injury on course	Volunteers/ Pupils	Medium	Ensure all Marshals have access to mobile phone or radio to report any problems and get help quickly if necessary.	<b>Low</b>

<b>Child Protection</b>	Risk to young people and vulnerable adults from child protection issues	All	Low/Medium	Ensure that only members of Staff from the Schools taking part and Partnership Staff are permitted to take photographs.	<b>Low</b>
	Risk to young people during the race.	Pupils, Volunteers	Low	Ensure that participants can be sited by at least two marshals at all times.	<b>Low</b>
<b>Bad Weather</b>	Risk of unsafe competition as a result of bad weather	All	Medium	Ensure that conditions are appropriate for the competition to go ahead/continue. If the weather conditions make it dangerous for the competition to go ahead/continue then competition should be cancelled.	<b>Low</b>
