Venue, Set Up and Equipment	Risk of injury through hazardous objects or wet flooring.	All	Medium	Ensure that the sports hall is checked for hazards/objects prior to the competition and these are safely removed. Any wet flooring is dried.	Low
	Risk of injury through participants bags/clothing being in the competition area.	All	Medium	Ensure all bags and clothing are stored against the wall and in the participants seating area.	Low
	Risk of injury through use of unsuitable/unsafe equipment	All	Medium	Ensure that all equipment is safe to use and replace any unsafe/broken equipment. Check equipment is assembled correctly prior to the competition.	Low
Track Events	Risk of injury through collision with other participants.	Pupils	High	Ensure that all participants are aware of other competitors and that the track lanes are sufficiently spaced. Do not allow crossing of track area at any time during races.	Low/Medium
	Risk of injury through incorrect technique	Pupils	Medium	Ensure there are demonstrations of each event prior to the start of races.	Low
Field Events	Risk of injury through unsafe practice whilst throwing events are taking place	All	Medium	Ensure that field events are set up safely and with adequate space. Throwing should take place towards a wall.	Low
Physical injuries	Risk of physical injury through participation in the Sportshall Athletics.	Pupils, Staff, Volunteers	Medium	Ensure adequate First Aid provision for the number of participants. Ensure adequate adult supervision of competition. First Aid kit should be brought by participating schools and any first aid should be carried out by the school's member of staff.	Low

	Risk of injury through inadequate warm up	Pupils	Medium	Ensure all participants warm up correctly prior to competition. Provide adequate time for warm up.	Low

Physical injuries cont...	Risk of injury through wearing inappropriate clothing.	Pupils	Medium	Ensure all participants wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the activity. Training shoes should be worn at all times.	Low
	Risk of injury through wearing jewellery	Pupils, Staff, Volunteers	Low	Ensure all participants remove or tape jewellery prior to the start of the competition. Competitors responsible for removing their own jewellery.	Low
	Risk of dehydration and exhaustion	All	Medium	Ensure there is adequate access to drinking water and encourage participants to bring drinks with them.	Low/Medium
Child Protection	Risk to young people and vulnerable adults from child protection issues	All	Low/Medium	Ensure that only staff from Schools participating and organising staff are permitted to take photos.	Low
