Year 4 Tri Golf Rules

- Each class should be split into A, B and C Teams
- The A Team must consist of 10 participants; 5 girls and 5 boys (Where possible, the B and C Teams should also follow this format)
- The tournament will follow the format of the National Golf Roots Competition for Primary Schools.
- Each team will complete all 8 of the activities (below)
- There will be 8 activities that focus on either chipping or putting:
 1. Bullseye (Chipping)
 2. Dominoes (Putting)
 3. Drive for Show, Putt for Dough (Chipping and putting)
 4. Finders Keepers (Putting)
 5. Grand National (Chipping)
 6. Tunnel Ball (Putting)
 7. Zone Ball (Putting)
 8. Go for the Green (Chipping)
- Each team will be given a warm up on each activity followed by time where they will be scored against the activity criteria
- The teams' scores for each activity will be added up to give a team total
- There will be a winning team with the highest total in the A, B and C competition
- The team who finish in 1st place in the A String of each Festival will be invited to represent their Family at the Partnership Final which will take place on Wednesday 24th October 2018 at Rickmansworth Golf Club.
