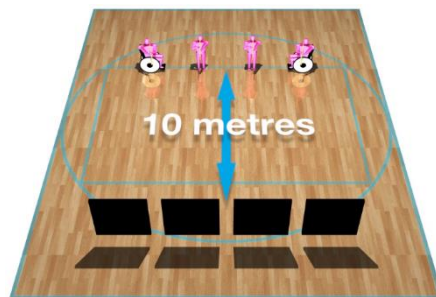


County Archery

Activity – Individual

- Each player will take it in turns to shoot 6 arrows
- Scores from all 6 arrows are added together to give an individual score



- Ensure archers are 10 metres away from the targets
- Archers should be wearing long sleeves or arm guards
- Have a briefing to explain safety and the competition to the participants
- Only collect arrows when it is safe to do so

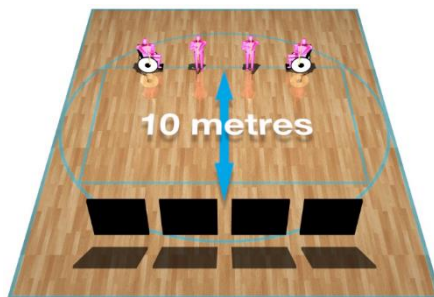

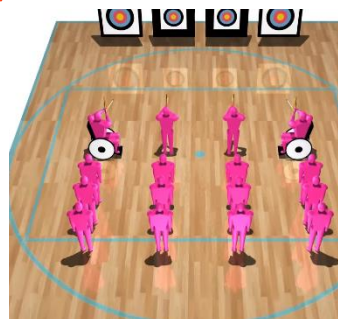
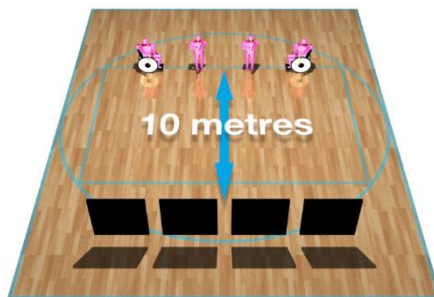

Scoring

Scoring may differ based on the archery sets you have access to

Whichever area the sucker is mostly covering should be the points awarded to the player

If the arrow drops off after initially sticking to the board, the player should still receive the points

If the arrow sticks to the board outside a designated points zone (red on the target opposite) then 1 point should be awarded

If the arrow misses the board completely the player scores 0
